

The BalconyPro is an expandable assembly that provides a quick and easy method for accurately marking baluster locations on level runs and balconies. The BalconyPro expands up to 6' and additional Marker Stick Assemblies (LJ-3090-1) can be purchased to increase the expansion up to 10'. Comes in a handy protective hard case.



Basic Guidelines

- Handrail shall be provided on porches, balconies or raised floor surfaces located more than 30 inches above the floor or grade below
- Open sides of stairs shall have handrails not less than 36 inches in height measured vertically from the nosing of the treads (SEE YOUR LOCAL CODE)
- Handrails are required to keep to a minimum height. Spacing between balusters is also regulated by code
- Curved, spiral, or winder stairs shall have the required handrail located on the outside radius
- Rail ends shall begin and terminate in newel posts or shall return to the wall
- The handgrip of the rail shall not be more than 2-5/8" across, or shall provide an equivalent gripping surface

Building Codes

BASIC GUIDELINES FOR WASHINGTON STATE BUILDING CODES*

Most of these regulations are taken from the Universal Building Code (UBC), but in many cases, counties make amendments to the UBC to ensure safety in residential construction. Please be sure you know the codes in the area in which you plan to build.

10" minimum run

7-3/4" maximum rise

Does it Meet Code? We do our best to keep building code information up-to-date and accurate. However, codes do change often and can be interpreted differently by different areas and inspectors. Please remember that you are responsible and liable for compliance with building codes.

Doing it Right the First Time When you are ready to install your stair system, call your local and/or state building agencies. Inform them of your project and ask them to assign an inspector. Contact that inspector and ask them to come to your building site and assist you in designing your stair system complying with all current codes. This will not only assure your compliance, but it also helps establish a good working relationship with your inspector, and let's them know that you are interested in meeting code. When the project is complete and inspection time comes, you will pass with flying colors.

4" maximum at widest point between spindles

Basic Guidelines

- Distance between tip of tread and ceiling shall be at least 6'8"
- Handrails projecting from a wall shall have a space of not less than 1-1/2" between the wall and rail
- The handgrip portion of handrails shall not be less than 1-1/2" inches across
- The handgrip portion of handrails shall have a smooth surface with no sharp corners
- Stairways more than 88" in width shall be provided with not less than one intermediate handrail

WOODCKAFTERS
A narrow, vertical member which helps support the handrail. Other names: spindle, picket
A collective term which refers to the newels, balusters, and handrail of a staiway.
That part of the fitting which widens in order to sit on a newel.
Made to order; to the customers specifications.
Generally, flat strips of finished lumber which fill the plow between balusters on plowed handrail and shoerail.
A fitting consisting of an upeasing, vertical rail drop and a level cap.
A newel post cut directly through the center, lengthwise, usually where handrail ends going to a wall.
A free bumper sticker. Ask your salesperson.
A newel situated at the turn on an L-shaped stair or winder.
A closed stair system with a housed or routed stringer.
A stair which has an intermediate landing at which point it continues upward at a 90° turn.
A level handrail fitting which turns 90°.
The major support for a balustrade system. Newels are larger than balusters and are located at the bottom and top of a stairway or at a turn in the handrail.
A stairway not boxed in by a wall on one or both sides.
A handrail fitting at the start of a level balustrade system.
Balustrade system which utilizes fittings to go over newel posts for an unbroken continuous handrail.
A handrail fitting which connects the value handrail with the level halcony
A handrail fitting which connects the rake handrail with the level balcony handrail without the use of a gooseneck.
The routed portion of a handrail or shoerail used for the inserting of square balusters. The gaps left between balusters are covered with fillet.
Perfectly vertical; established with a level.
Balustrade system in which the handrail is not continuous. The handrail is attached to the face of a square-top newel. The angle or ascent of a stairway. This is determined by the rise and run.
The vertical distance from one tread to the next tread.
The vertical distance from one riser to the next riser.
A railing running along the floor on a balcony or atop a kneewall stringer which is plowed for the insertion of balusters and fillet.
Not a stock item; must be ordered from an outside source; an opportunity for something unique and different.
A stairway with no turns or intermediate landings.
The supporting members which run the length of the stairway on which treads and risers are mounted.
The portion of the tread which protrudes beyond the face of the riser.
A handrail fitting used on a volute newel which turns away from the stairway in a circular fashion.




